The Meaning of "Adam-ondi-Ahman"

IBLEY derives the meaning "Adam (or man) in the presence of God" by reference to Egyptian: *Atum* ("Adam" or "man"⁸⁹¹), *ondi* (i.e., "in the presence of," "at," "by," "around"⁸⁹²), *Amen* (also "Amun," or "Amon").⁸⁹³

Marquardt points out that the Kirtland "Grammar and Alphabet of the Egyptian Language," in the handwriting of William W. Phelps, contains a reference to "The place appointed of God for the residence of Adam; Adam ondi= Ahman." Adam-ondi-Ahman has also been described as "the place where Adam shall come to visit his people, or the Ancient of Days shall sit," the place where Adam dwelt," or "Valley of God where Adam dwelt." Matthews also mentions the following interpretations or descriptions: "Adam's consecrated land," Adam's grave" Adam's grave" Adam's grave" Adam's grave" Adam's grave" He also cites the following from Elder Alvin R. Dyer, which relates the name "to the priesthood and revelatory experience of Adam in being the first man to hold the spiritual blessings of the gospel":

The very word itself speaks of the manner in which Adam has received the "Keys of Salvation" under the counsel and direction of the Holy One, who is Jesus Christ the Lord.

The word "Adam" refers directly to Adam. The word "ondi," means nearby or connected with. The word "Ahman" means the Lord himself. Therefore a literal translation of the words "Adamondi-Ahman" means The Lord Jesus Christ, through Adam unto mankind." 900

Elsewhere, President Dyer remarks:

In conferring the "keys of salvation" upon Adam, the revealing and unlocking of the conditions of salvation were made known to them and through them to mankind. In this we can understand the true meaning of the term "Adam-ondi-Ahman," or simply: from "Ahman," who is the Lord, "ondi," meaning through Adam unto mankind. 901

With respect to the term "Ahman," Orson Pratt cited a revelation by Joseph Smith saying that it "signifies God... in the original language spoken by Adam." Tvedtnes conjectures that since: "Joseph Smith is said to have indicated that... Jesus is called 'Son Ahman,'903 Old Testament prayers end simply with the word 'Amen' (= confirmed, true), and hence in the name (title) of Jesus Christ." ⁹⁰⁴
